Applicants are required to fit the following criteria:

1. A Baccalaureate degree in either an Engineering or Physical Science discipline.
2. An Undergraduate grade point average in Engineering, Science and Mathematics courses of 3.2 on a 4.0 scale.
3. A minimum of three (3) letters of strong support from former teachers or supervisors.
4. A minimum combined verbal and quantitative score of 1150 on the Graduate Record Examination Aptitude Test (GRE).
5. A minimum score of 550 on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) for students whose first language is not English and have not received a degree from a college or university in which English is the sole language of instruction.

Admission into the Department of Materials Science and Engineering is selective and competitive based on the number of well qualified applicants and the limits of available faculty and facilities. Applicants who meet stated minimum academic requirements are not guaranteed admission.
